Job Description - Number 1 Mechanic/GT Specialist

Major Functions and Accountabilities:

- Sign off on each vehicle after service as quality control to ensure safety.
- The position works with the race cars in all forms of construction, repair, performance development, parts manufacture and maintenance.
- Responsible for the manufacturing of new components, development parts, test components, research and development parts.
- Responsible for the repair and maintenance of all precision components of a race car.
- Scheduling test sessions, working with drivers on track, carrying out setup changes during test sessions.
- Developing the performance / maintaining and repairing the race cars.

- Specialist set-up techniques of the race car, including but not limited to wheel alignment, corner weight, weight distribution, roll ratio, spring and shock absorber setting and adjustment.

- Ideally has experience working in culturally diverse environments and teams.

- Ideally has extensive knowledge and experience in running GT3 level cars at a minimum of a National Championship level, including but not limited to:
 - Assembly.
 - Fault finding.
 - Engine diagnostics.
 - Engine building and repair.
 - Bodywork and composite repair.
 - Race setup.
 - On track running – Race meetings and test events.
